Activity 1

1. Read the following text carefully:

Michael the Brave was the first ruler who united the three Romanian countries: Wallachia, Transylvania and Moldova. He was born in 1558, in Oltenia, and in 1593 he became lord of Wallachia. His first major victory was in 1595, when in Călugăreni, in the fight against the Turks, he won the independence of Wallachia.

He succeeded in uniting Romania with Transylvania in 1599 after a battle in October at Șelimbăr, and on November 1, the same year, he entered Alba Iulia, triumphant.

In the year 1600 (May), the union of the two small countries with Moldova became a reality.

In September 1600 he lost a battle at Mirăslău, and in August 1601 he was killed at Câmpia Turzii.
